**Charles David "Dave" Gregory**  
**November 16, 1929 – March 18, 2015**

Dave Gregory; student and instructor to both families and friends, always willing to learn and to share his knowledge. This kind, gentle, loving man was a friend to all, Father to 5, Grandfather to 12 and Great-Grandfather to 9.

Dave was born in Albany CA and later joined the Air Force to serve his Country during the Korean War. While stationed in Louisiana he met Janeva "Jan", his soon to be wife. Dave and Jan moved to CA in 1954 and celebrated 56 loving years of marriage before Jan passed in 2009. Dave never remarried but in 2012 shared a commitment ceremony with special friend, Doris Miller.

National Cash Register was blessed to have Dave in their employment for 25 years before he decided to move on to other job opportunities. His time with NCR also inspired him to add many aged cash registers to his collections.

Dave loved being with people and had the gift of making everyone feel important and special. His love of people, gift of helping and a passion for wood carving, led him to serve as a volunteer for many years at the Pleasanton Sr. Center.

As a lover of golf, he delighted in many a game with the SIRS group and also enjoyed working at the Castlewood Golf Course. Some of Dave's other interests were a passion for collecting tools (both old and new) as well as books that helped fill his thirst for knowledge and provided peace during quite times.

As an avid tool collector, it only seems natural that Dave was an active member of Tri-Valley Wood Carvers since the 1970's as well as a member of the California Carvers Guild. His gentle, patient nature served him well during the many years he taught carving classes, which also included the tough job of sharpening of tools.

When Dave passed away the folks on Earth lost a great man but Heaven gained another special soul and an awesome carver.

As a very humble man, Dave was adamant that there be no services but we will always honor him in our hearts as we remember his wry smile, gentle eyes and subtle sense of humor!

The ultimate wood carving challenge –to carve a 500 year old oak tree into the female human form. See how the artist approaches his task, how he thinks and how he successfully



carves a beautiful woman's face in the tree, using a chain saw and chisels.

His most famous work to date is ['The Goddess in the Forest'](#) carved into a living tree which was hit by lightning at [Cae Mabon](#) in Snowdonia, North Wales, UK. This woodcarving sculpture is not only remarkable for its captivating beauty, but also for the story behind it. There are not many woodcarvers who will attempt the female human form as it is so difficult to get right. Many people will carve bears and other animals as the thick coats give relatively amorphous forms rather than the delicate bone structure of a person.
